### Northern Development Initiative Trust - Capital Investment Analysis

Funding available for an advanced case business study that leads to final investment decision for a major capital infrastructure project.

Nechako-Kitamaat Development Fund – Economic Development Grants Eligible grant of 50% of project budget taking place in Electoral Areas B,D,E, and F Application Deadlines: October 25, 2016 or February 1, 2017 Supports programs that address economic development, including Planning and Research.
