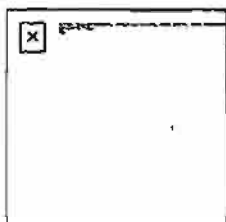

The girls on this team practice 4 days a week and play in tournaments on weekends. They get to travel to all corners of the province to meet girls of the same age and interests and compete against them in the tournaments.

The girls on this team all attend Fort St James Secondary school. We have players from Nak'azdli and Tl'Azt'en bands and many who live within and outside of the town boundaries.

The team and all the trips are completely run and organized by volunteers. Many of the volunteers have to take time off work to help out with the team.

The Sr Girls Soccer team won the North Central Zone Championships to earn the opportunity to represent our region, community, and school at the Provincial Tournament. These provincial trips are much more expensive than a regular tournament trips due to extra days and typically longer distances travelled. The help we receive from the RD and other organizations is essential to making these trips to Provincial Championships possible for many of our players.

Describe how this proposal will benefit the community:

These trips allow many of our students to experience different parts of the province that they may never otherwise be able to. For example many girls on this team over the last few years have been able to tour UVIC and UBC because of a Provincial Soccer tournament being held close by. Last year my team stayed in dorms at UBC and experienced what it would be like to attend the university. They were also able to tour the UBC Museum of Anthropology which was a great experience. This year the tournament is being held in Surrey and the girls will be able to see the many attractions that Surrey has to offer. These trips to Provincial Championship Tournaments also allow our girls from the north to test themselves against the very best competition in the Province. The girls are often surprised by how well they do against teams that can play 10 months of the year. The experiences these girls will have at the tournament will last a lifetime.

FLESS is the only elementary/secondary school in Fraser Lake. In addition to providing quality education, the school provides students with the opportunity to participate in academic, athletic, and leadership activities. Participation in the FLESS golf team is available to students in Grades 8-12. To qualify for the golf team, students participated in several qualifying rounds of golf. This year the team is made up of two players from Grade 8 and three players from Grade 9. The activities provided by the school are not the same as those offered in the community from another organization or agency.

Students in Grades 4-12 from Fraser Lake, Fort Fraser, Endako, Nadleh, Stellaten, and the surrounding rural areas attend FLESS. Female and male students in Grades 8-12 are eligible to participate on the golf team.

The team will receive \$350 from both the school and the school district to put towards the registration fees for the trip. Fund raising opportunities are being explored, which include a bottle drive, donation jar at the local golf course, and possibly a BBQ.

The referral for this application was originally received by the Regional District in September 2013 and was for a 2 year temporary permit under the *Lands Act*. The referral documents for the renewal are the same documents that were provided in 2013. At the September 12, 2013 Rural Directors Committee meeting the following motion was passed:

"That the Rural Directors Committee receive Land Referral Application No. 6408576."



The application area (NW 1/4 DL 4173, Range 5, Coast District) is located approximately 1200 metres north of the Village of Burns Lake, along the proposed Northern Gateway Pipelines route, and is 3.96 ha in size. The applicant proposes to do geophysical surveys and drilling of boreholes to investigate subsurface conditions and collect subsurface technical data from five test sites. The data will eventually be used to evaluate the planning and engineering of the proposed Northern Gateway Pipelines, should development of the pipeline proceed. The drilling sites will be accessed by existing roads. Some clearing of trees is required and the drilling will require the use of water from local sources.



The drilling sites will be accessed by existing roads and will require use of water taken from local sources.

According to our mapping records there are residences located in the vicinity of two of the application areas, 6408581 (Owen Creek/Houston Pump Station) and 6408582 (Buck Creek), as can be seen below.
