Chair Petersen mentioned that they recognized that it was a top priority but were unable to access funds.

Director Newell mentioned that at the last Northern Health Joint meeting it was indicated that the need for long-term care beds is expected to increase 300%. He commented that there needed to be on the ground work and plans to move forward in providing seniors care facilities.
