Good Morning CAOs.

We've reached out to both UBCM and the Passenger Transportation Board regarding the potential loss of Greyhound service in the region.

- 1.) Prince George has offered to explore suitable responses in the coming days, and to coordinate with any of you who might want to provide input, or who are considering responses of your own.
- 2.) Communities are welcome to write in with their concerns directly to the PTSB. Greyhound, however, hasn't actually submitted an application to alter their service at this point.
- 3.) My understanding is that this issue fits the criteria for a late resolution at UBCM (which would have to be submitted prior to September 22nd for consideration). In such circumstances, the issue has to have emerged after their June 30th resolution deadline, and it must not have been known as a potential issue before that time.

Ministry of Forests, Lands, Natural Resource Operations and Rural Development BC Wildfire Service

Campfires to be allowed again in all of northern B.C.

SMITHERS – Effective at noon on Thursday, 5ept. 7, 2017, campfires will once again be allowed in the entire Northwest Fire Centre.

The combination of a return to more seasonal weather conditions and the lack of significant wildfire activity has reduced the risk of wildfire in the northwest.

However, the prohibition against open fires larger than a campfire (0.5 metres by 0.5 metres) will remain in effect within the entire Northwest Fire Centre.

A map of the affected areas and their associated prohibitions is available online: http://ow.ly/mDWG30eXt0A

The following activities will remain prohibited:

- Category 2 and Category 3 open fires as defined in the wildfire regulation: http://www.bclaws.ca/civix/document/id/loo92/loo92/11 38 2005
- the use of sky lanterns, binary exploding targets, air curtain burners, fireworks, including firecrackers and burning barrels or burning cages of any size or description

These prohibitions cover all BC Parks, Crown lands and private lands, but do not apply within the boundaries of a local government that has forest fire prevention bylaws and is serviced by a fire department. Always check with local authorities to see if any other burning restrictions are in place before lighting any fire.

Anyone found in contravention of an open burning prohibition may be issued a ticket for \$1,150, required to pay an administrative penalty of \$10,000 or, if convicted in court, fined up to \$100,000 and/or sentenced to one year in jail. If the contravention causes or contributes to a wildfire, the person responsible may be ordered to pay all firefighting and associated costs.


